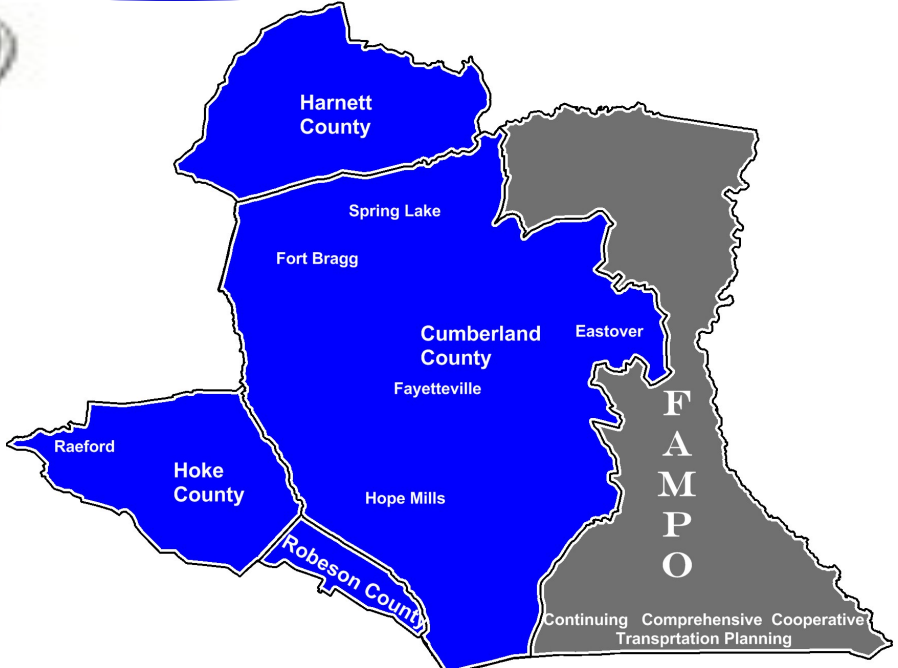

Fayetteville Regional Airport Expands Service to Washington, D.C.

Fayetteville Regional Airport is adding more service to Washington, D.C. United Airlines now provides three round trip flights from Washington Dulles International Airport to Fayetteville. United Express regional carrier CommutAir serves the Fayetteville market with 37 passenger Q200 airplanes and flight time is about an hour and 20 minutes. In 2012, a direct flight was added from Fayetteville to Reagan National Airport in D.C. United's new flights will also offer Fayetteville customers access to United's worldwide network, including efficient connections to Honolulu, Frankfurt, Munich, Dubai, Doha, and more.



Big Cross Creek Greenway Study

FAMPO, in coordination with NCDOT Bicycle and Pedestrian Division and the City of Fayetteville, will soon begin a study to determine the best routing for a multiuse trail similar to the Cape Fear River Trail that will extend from Smith Lake on Ft. Frequency of Ramsey Street Accidents Declines

Recently released data show that the frequency of accidents on Ramsey Street has declined following the completion of roadway improvements requested by the City of Fayetteville. The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) completed roadway improvements that include a raised median and landscaping. The NCDOT has completed a three-month evaluation of the roadway and the safety improvements that have been constructed along Ramsey Street from Country Club Drive northward to the Fayetteville Outer Loop.



The evaluation included an analysis of the before and after crash information along this section of roadway. The total number of crashes for the three years prior to construction of the improvements was 774 total crashes, or 258 crashes per year (CPY). The total crashes during the three-month evaluation period after construction was 29 total crashes, a projection of 116 CPY. The types of crashes per year, targeted by the improvements, (angle, left turn, sideswipe, and rear ends in the previous center left turn lane) were reduced from 166 total crashes, or 55.3 CPY, in the previous three years, to zero total crashes, during the three-month evaluation. NCDOT will continue to monitor the location and provide six-month, nine-month, and one-year supplemental reports after period crash data is available.

Air Quality Update

The air quality forecast season is from April 1 to October 31. This is the time during the year when our air quality is at its worst. For our 2013 Air Quality Awareness project we will be partnering with Sustainable Sandhills to implement the Ozone Advance Program. As we head into the 2013 Ozone Season, keep in mind that this will be an important time for reducing our ground-level ozone, as the EPA proposes stricter standards. If Cumberland County becomes non-attainment for ozone, there will be significant impacts to transportation planning and the business community.
