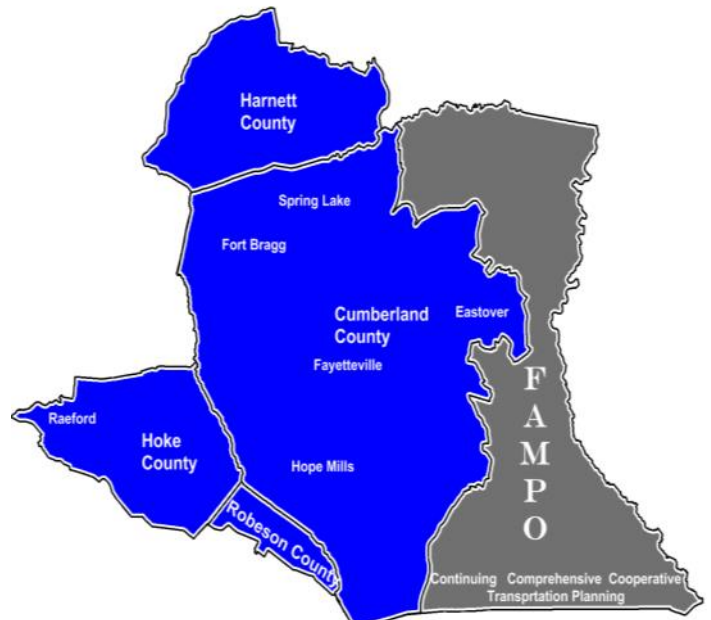

SPOT 5.0

The NCDOT Project Prioritization Process, known as SPOT 5.0, is currently at the end of the project review stage for the FAMPO area. The projects will be re-viewed and scored quantitatively by the state, with the scores released on April 3rd. The projects will then be open for local input scoring over the course of the Spring and Summer of 2018. The local input methodology was approved by TPB on January 24th, and can be found on our website or in person at the FAMPO office.

Projects which receive funding will be placed into the next State Transportation Improvement Program to begin design and construction in the near future. As the point assignment process moves forward, FAMPO will be seeking public input via public meetings, public comment forms, and electronic submissions. Vehicle Occupancy Rates (VOR) Survey

FAMPO will be conducting the Vehicle Occupancy Rate (VOR) study during the week of April 30th and May 14th 2018. The VOR report is required by the North Carolina Department of Transportation as part of transportation system monitoring and results are used to improve conditions for safety, reducing traffic congestion, and improving efficiency. Surveys will be conducted in the Fort Bragg/Pope Air Field area and the Fayetteville Central Business District (CBD) areas. The complete report will be available to the public in June.
