

Cumberland County Jurisdictions Join the Ozone Advance Program

Cumberland County, City of Fayetteville, and the Towns of Eastover, Falcon, Godwin, Hope Mills, Linden, Spring Lake, Stedman, and Wade are participating in the new Ozone Advance Program. This Program is administered through the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and is designed to encourage areas that are close to being designated as non-attainment for ozone to implement voluntary measures to reduce pollutants. By doing so, areas like the Fayetteville Metropolitan Area can be better prepared to reduce the impacts of a potential re-designation in the future. Our area is the first in North Carolina to participate.
