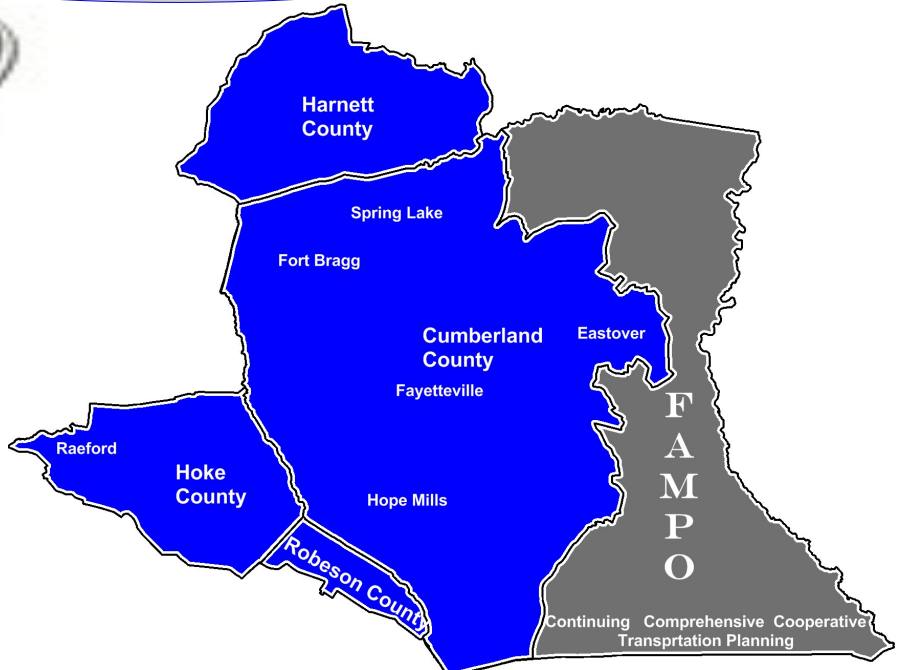

2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Update

FAMPO has begun the process of updating the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP). The MTP is a fiscally constrained plan that identifies multi-modal transportation needs for the planning area for the next 30 years. The MTP is updated every 5 years, and was last updated in 2009.

During the Public Involvement Process, FAMPO staff will hold several walk-in meetings to solicit citizens' and stakeholders' input.

A 10 question survey has been posted on our website, www.fampo.org, and will be open until at least November 1st. Completing this survey will help in shaping the Transportation Plan. *(Continued on next page.)*

Fayetteville Outer Loop Progress

The Fayetteville Outer Loop is currently under construction from Ramsey Street to the All American Expressway. About \$100 million was allocated in 2012 for the 5.8-mile segment from the freeway to Cliffdale Road. That will be put out to bid in April. The 2.5-mile section from Cliffdale Road to Raeford Road is expected to cost around \$70 million.
