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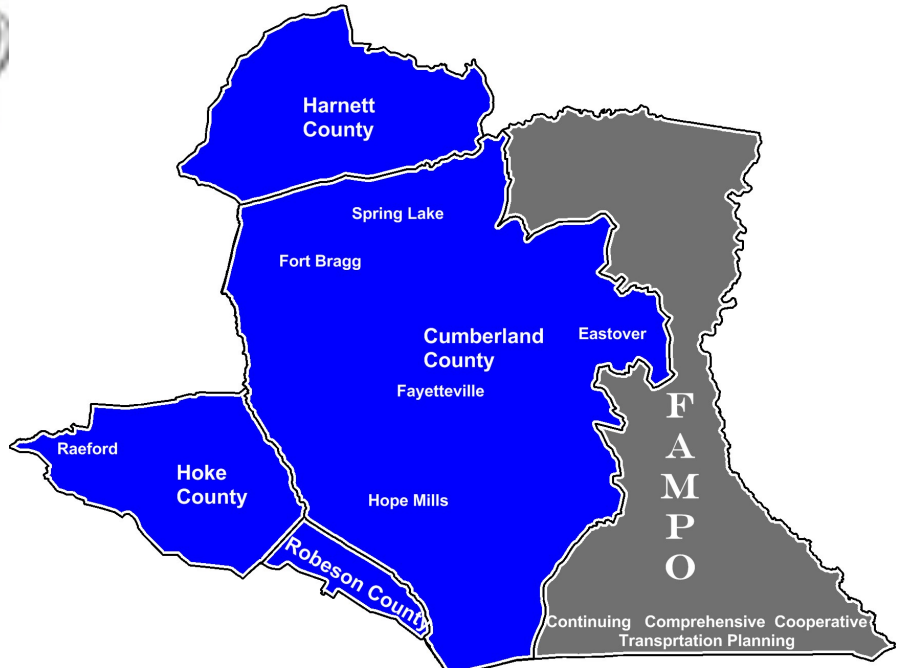
## Project Prioritization SPOT 4.0

The Fayetteville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization has been diligently working on prioritizing transportation projects for the State of North Carolina's Strategic Transportation Investment program. The draft list of funded projects released December 13, 2016. Barring any changes, 10 of the 17 Division Level projects FAMPO awarded points to in P4.0 will be funded, to include a bike/ped project in the region. The Board of Transportation is expected to adopt the final STIP in June 2017.
