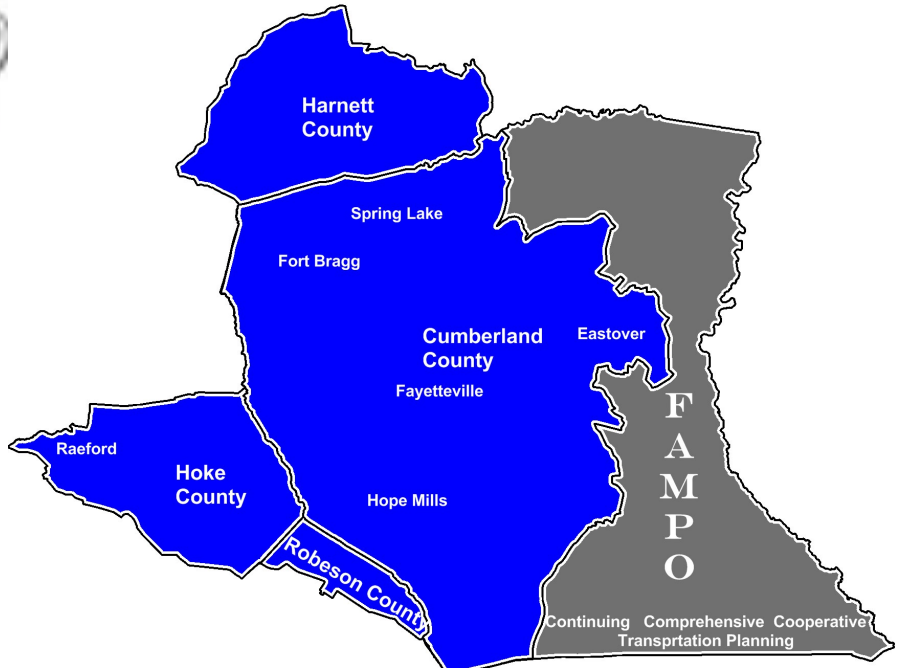
### Project Prioritization SPOT 4.0

The Fayetteville Area Metropolitan Planning Organization has been diligently working on prioritizing transportation projects for the State of North Carolina's Strategic Transportation Investment program. Currently, the Divisional level of prioritization is ongoing (see page 2) and the scoring is being distributed for public review. The draft list of funded projects and their timeframe for construction should be released this Winter.

### Major Changes with Bragg Boulevard Closure

Following years of planning post 9/11, Fort Bragg officially closed portions of Bragg Boulevard to through traffic August 17, 2016 for security reasons. Bragg Boulevard traffic has since been rerouted to Murchison Road/210 and future I-295.
